

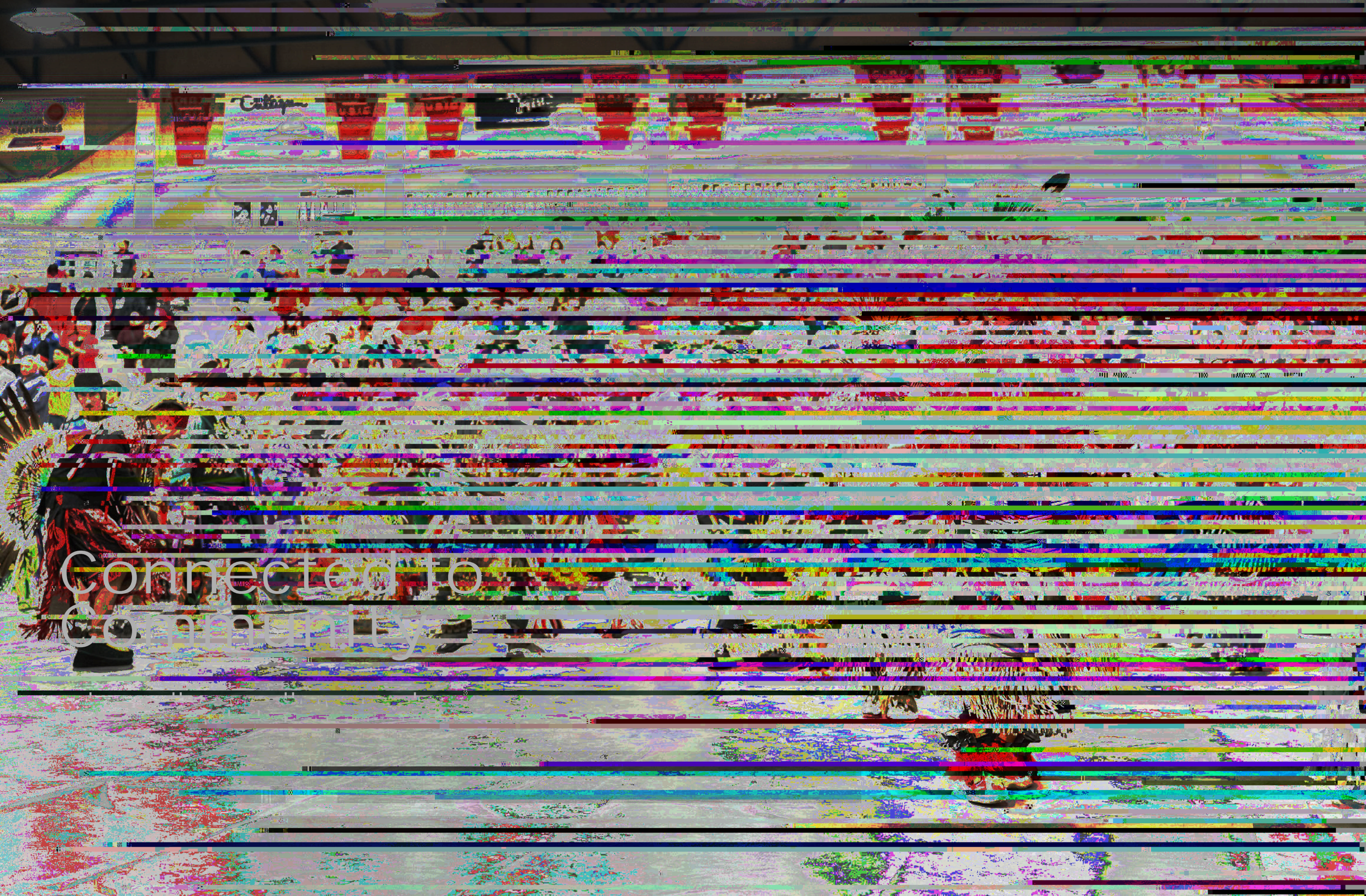


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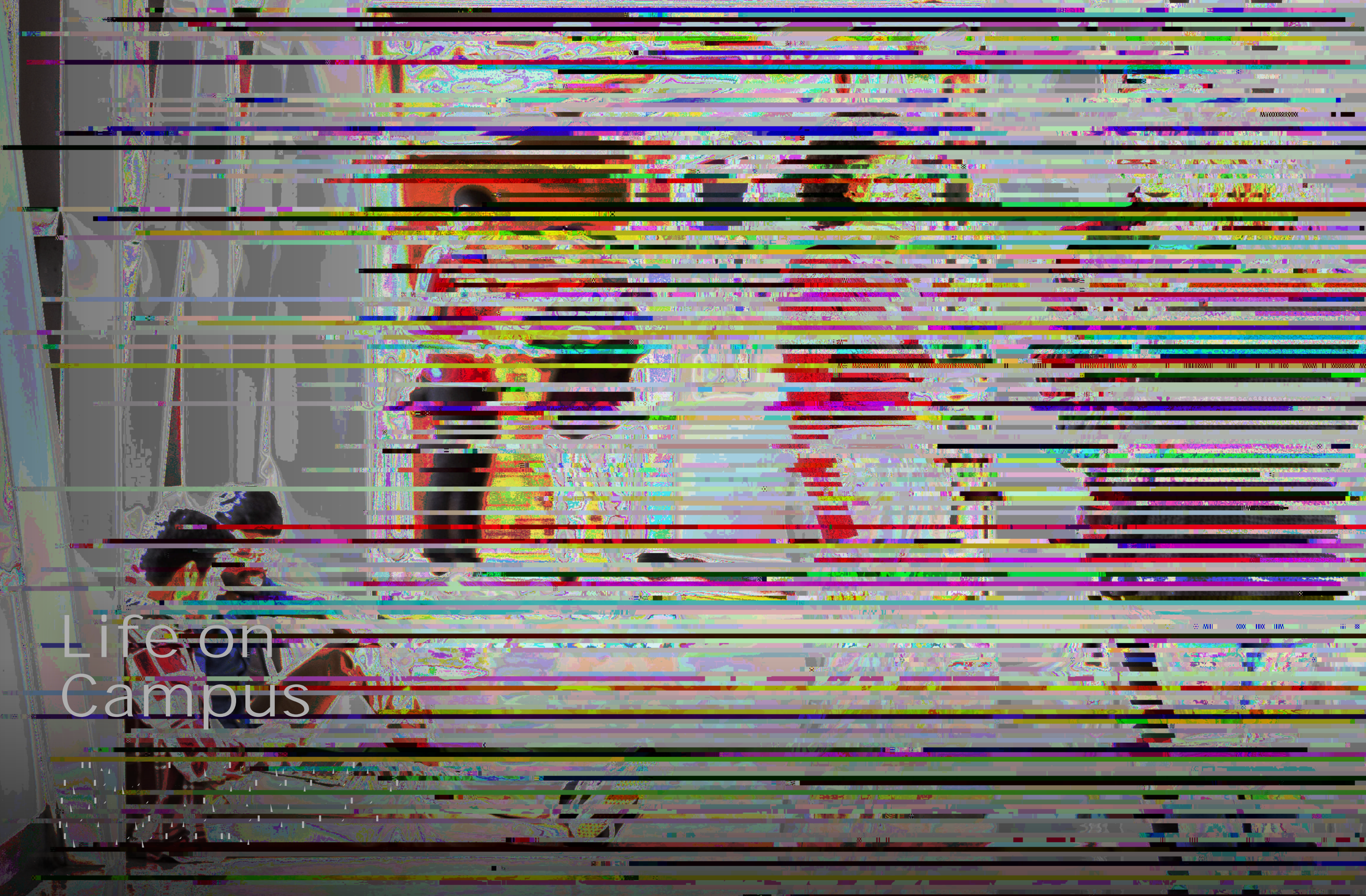

## Program Overview

The University of Winnipeg's TESL Certificate Program is a 12-month, full-time program designed to prepare graduates for careers in English as a Second Language (ESL) education. The program is delivered through a combination of classroom instruction and practical experience.

• Navigate the TESL profession and industry.

• Network with TESL professionals and organizations.

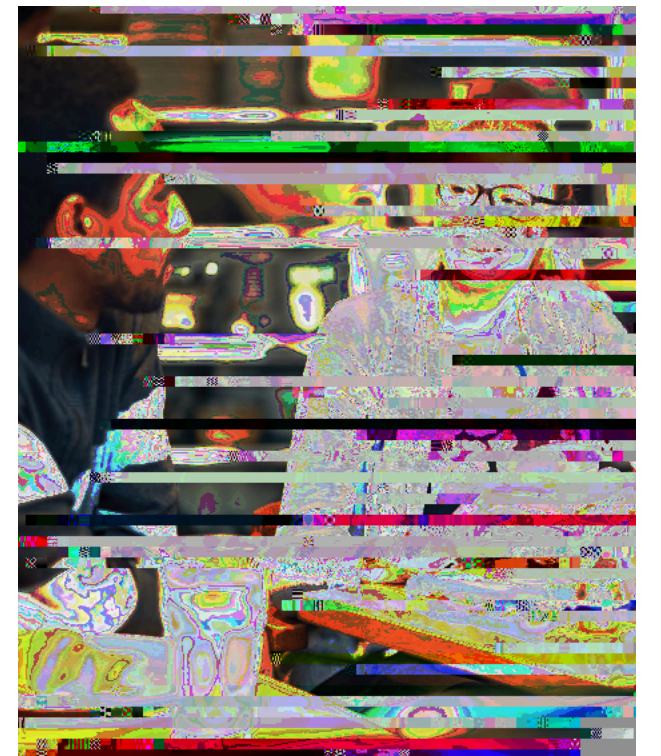
