Be accountable: Be accountable for your part of the group. You should be able to explain your contribution.

Offer and request feedback: Offer and request feedback from your group members. You should be able to give and receive constructive criticism.

Explain your ideas: Explain your ideas clearly and concisely. You should be able to articulate your thoughts and opinions.

It will take longer: It will take longer to complete the task if you do not work together. You should be able to manage your time effectively.
